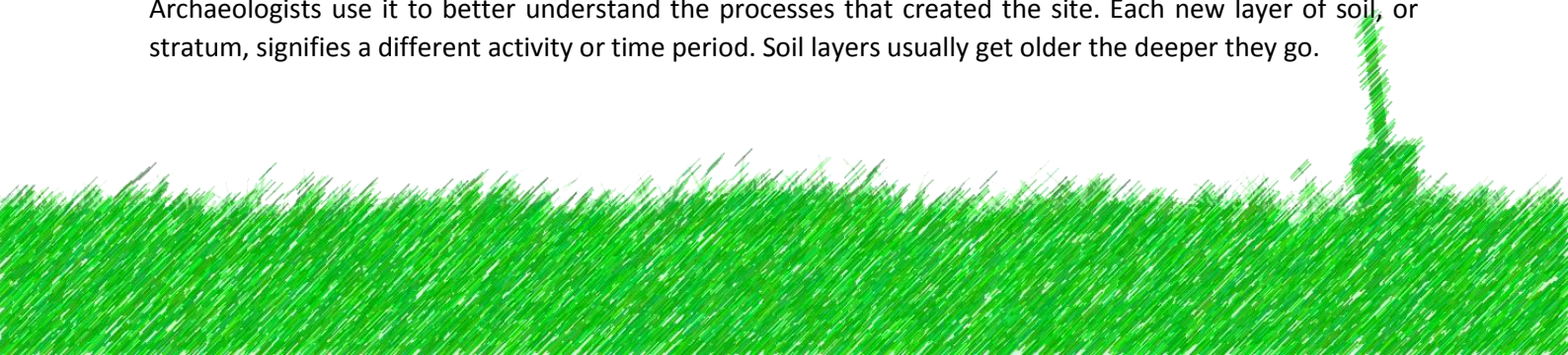
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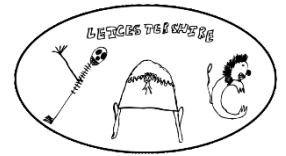

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 is the study of soil layers.

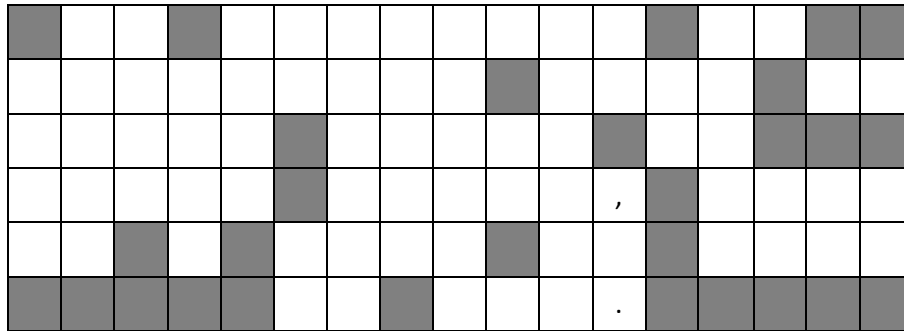

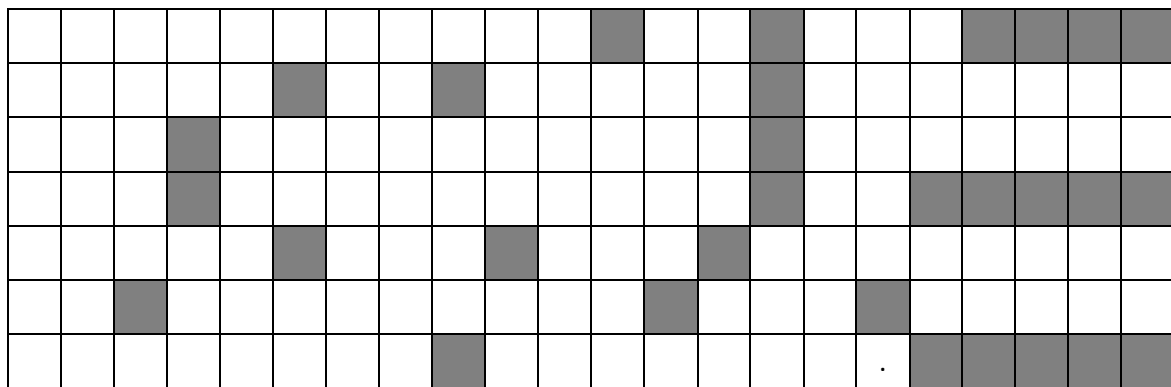

Get the letters in the correct order and work out what the messages say. The letters are shown correctly beneath each column, you need to work out which row they belong in. It is trial and error, good luck!

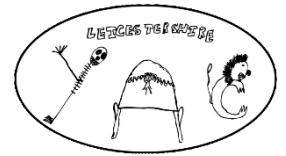
